In the Board of Commissioners room at the Asotin County Courthouse Annex, 095 2nd Street, Asotin, Washington, until 2:00 p.m., P.D.T. January 11, 2017 at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids must be completed on a lump sum and unit price basis as indicated on the **BID PROPOSAL**, and the total as defined in the Special Provisions will be used for the purpose of comparison of bids for the **SR 129/Fleshman Way I/C Improvements Project**. Award of the construction contract will be to the lowest responsible bidder.

Work includes the improvement of Fleshman Way and SR 129 in Asotin County, by rebuilding the interchange with HMA and cement concrete pavement, retaining walls, guardrail, drainage, illumination, permanent signing, and other related work. Asotin County, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000-d to 2000-4, and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination on federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit

bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

This project is being jointly funded through Asotin County, the Washington State Transportation Improvement Board (TIB), and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

No bidder may withdraw his bid within thirty (30) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
