Sealed bids for the following described construction will be received by the Asotin County Public Works Department:

In the Board of Commissioners room at the Asotin County Courthouse Annex, 095 2nd Street, Asotin, Washington, until 2:00 p.m., P.D.T. October 13, 2020 at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Bids must be completed on a lump sum and unit price basis as indicated on the BID PROPOSAL, and the total as defined in the Special Provisions will be used for the purpose of comparison of bids for the **Lower Evans Road Reconstruction Project**. Award of the construction contract will be to the lowest responsible bidder.

Work includes the improvement of Lower Evans Road by removing existing hot mix asphalt (HMA) and sub-base and replacing with new crushed surfacing and HMA, traffic control and other related work. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities, minor defects, or to reject any or all bids. Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid amount, subject to the conditions provided for in the bid procedures and conditions.

Asotin County, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C. 2000-d to 2000-4, and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, nondiscrimination on federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it

will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises as defined at 49 FR Part 26 will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color or national origin or sex in consideration for an award.

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract.

This project includes Federal funds and is subject to the wage provisions of the Washington State Public Works Laws, Federal Davis-Bacon, and related acts. Payments to the Contractor will not be made unless Intent to Pay Prevailing Wages have been filed and approved for the Prime Contractor and all subcontractors.

No bidder may withdraw his bid within thirty (30) days after the actual date of the opening thereof.

Prospective Bidders shall make all requests for clarifications related to the project to the County in writing no later than September 29, 2020. No verbal clarifications will be made.
